I, Ved Prakash, Practising Company Secretary (ACS: 36837; CP: 16986) and Designated Partner of M/s. S. 1. The Compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made thereunder relating to voting through electronic means ('remote e-voting') and voting by use of ballot by the shareholders on the resolutions proposed in the notice of the 47th Annual General Meeting of the Company is the responsibility of the management. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer is to ensure that the voting process both through electronic means and through ballot are conducted in a fair and transparent manner and submit the consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, to the Chairman on the resolutions, based on the report generated electronically or by voting through ballot.

- 2. As per the Notice of 47th Annual General Meeting of the Shareholders and the 'Advertisement' published pursuant to Rule 20 (4) (v) of the Companies [(Management and Administration) Rules, 2014] (Amendment Rules, 2015) on September 01, 2017, in "Active Times" and on September 02, 2017 in "Mumbai Lakshadeep", the remote e-voting opened at 09.00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 20, 2017 and remained open until 05.00 p.m. on Friday, September 22, 2017.
- 3. The Shareholders holding the Equity Shares of the Company as on Friday, September 15, 2017 viz. the "cut-off date", were entitled to vote on the resolutions stated in the Notice of the 47th Annual General Meeting of the Company.
- 4. After the declaration of voting by use of ballot by the Chairman at the meeting, ballot box was locked and kept for voting duly marked by identification mark placed on them. The ballot box subsequently on close of voting hours was opened in the presence of two witnesses who are not the employees of the Company, and ballots received were serially numbered, sorted, signatures verified and were scrutinized and initialed by the scrutinizer.
